Who should submit proposals?

Classroom teachers, teacher trainers, coordinators, researchers, students, educators and everyone interested in exploring learning opportunities expansion and how AI can support language teaching and learning in diverse ELT contexts.

We especially welcome submissions from teachers who are experimenting with AI, reflecting on early or ongoing classroom implementations, or exploring pedagogical questions related to AI use in ELT. Proposals may present practices in development, reflective analyses, or lessons learned—not only finalized or large-scale projects.

Important clarification

Proposals do not require advanced technical knowledge. The focus of the conference is on pedagogical decision-making, classroom practice, teacher agency, and the educational impact of AI-supported tools and approaches.

ANUPI & COPEI promote a critical, ethical, and pedagogically grounded approach to artificial intelligence in education, emphasizing the teacher's role as a reflective practitioner, designer, and mediator of learning. Share your expertise, your good practices with colleagues and enjoy learning from others.

Submission Guidelines

- Proposals should be submitted online by **30 May 2026**.
- Proposals will be peer-reviewed by the conference review committee based on the following criteria: relevance, practicality, engagement, originality, and significance.
- Notification of acceptance will be sent **by 20 June 2026**.
- Accepted presenters will be required to register for the conference by **11 July 2026**.

Submitting your proposal: Fill out your proposal completely including:
Title, presenters' names, biodata, topic and area of interest.

Each presenter must register individually.

Title: Clear and related to the conference (12-15 words)

Summary (50-60 words): They guide the participants to choose according to their interests.

Biodata: 50-70 words- use third person- relevant experience

Abstracts: 250 words

- a) State the theoretical background
- b) Mention objectives and provide examples if necessary.
- c) Provide quotes following APA and Include your bibliography.

Presentation Types:

Papers & demonstrations: Speaker's presentation, informative, includes Q&A. Duration: **20** minutes, including a 5-minute Q&A 5 minutes to change rooms.

Workshops: Interactive, hands-on, participatory, collaborative, skill-building.
Duration: **40** minutes, including a 10-minute Q&A session and 5 minutes to change rooms.

Panel discussion: Active interaction among presenters.
Duration: **1.15** minutes, including a 10-minute Q&A session and 5 minutes to change rooms.

Exhibitor's session:
Duration: **20** minutes, including a 5-minute Q&A session and 5 minutes to change rooms.
